

GLOBAL ORGANIC TEXTILE STANDARD CERTIFIED COTTON

The Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS) is the worldwide leading textile processing standard for organic fibers, including ecological and social criteria, backed up by independent certification of the entire textile supply chain. Version 5.0 was published on the 1st of March 2017, 3 years after the Version 4.0 was introduced and 12 years after the launch of the 1st Version. The high ecological and social requirements as well as worldwide practicability and verifiability were considered in the revision work, in order to achieve a reliable and transparent set of criteria.

The aim of the Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS) is to define world-wide recognized requirements that ensure organic status of textiles, from harvesting of the raw materials, through environmentally and socially responsible manufacturing up to labeling in order to provide credible assurance to the end consumer. Textile processing, manufacturing, and trading entities can apply for certification according to the Global Organic Textile Standard.

The GOTS certification earned by WPT Nonwovens allows us to export organic cotton nonwoven materials with a single certification that is accepted in all major markets.

In order for a final product to be sold, labeled, or represented as GOTS certified, all operators of the processing and manufacturing chain, as well as B2B traders, must be GOTS certified.
